WHERE WE STAY

Week 1 — Kenya

All volunteers begin their stay in Nairobi, with a day to rest, settle in, and — depending on your arrival time — do a little sightseeing before heading to Kimilili. Be prepared to stay in an Airbnb on arrival and departure. The drive from Nairobi to Kimilili is about seven hours, so rest will be needed. In Kimilili, volunteers stay in a small local hotel.

Week 2 — Rwanda

Two-week volunteers continue on to Rwanda. Please bring a twin-size sheet set for the Airbnb. For the last two nights we will stay at the four-star Grand Legacy Hotel to relax and enjoy its amenities.

FOOD

Breakfast, lunch, and a light supper are served daily. All meals are plant-based (vegan).

- Bring snacks for the plane ride. You are welcome to keep personal snacks on hand at all times.
- Refrigeration is limited, so pack non-perishables: energy bars, nuts, trail mix, pretzels, etc.



WEATHER

Average daytime temperatures in Kimilili and Kigali almost always fall between 70 and 80 °F. Record highs have topped 90 °F, and lows have dipped to 60 °F. Evenings are cooler, so bring a light hooded jacket or raincoat.

HEALTH & VACCINATIONS

Check the CDC travel website to see which vaccinations you need for Kenya and Rwanda. Anti-malaria medication is optional but recommended. For at least four weeks before travel, focus on being in your best health (eating well, resting, exercising) so your immune system is functioning at its best.

TRANSPORTATION

If you are not on the group flight from Atlanta, please email your airline itinerary to contactus@oasiswholelife.org so we can arrange pickup and drop-off at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (Nairobi) and Kigali International Airport.

Transportation is provided for group travel, trips to local markets and stores, and souvenir shopping. Roads are not well developed in some areas, so travel may take longer than usual. Don't forget your best walking shoes!

LANGUAGE

Kenya's common language is Swahili; Rwanda's is Kinyarwanda. English is widely spoken in both countries except in very rural areas. Team members will be on hand to interpret.

MONEY

Your trip is paid in full before departure. Bring spending money for personal shopping, extra food, and souvenirs.

- Exchange money at the airport or a local exchange when you arrive, and change it back to US dollars before you leave.
- Credit cards are accepted in only a few places.
- Bring US cash in \$5 bills. Many small merchants can't make change in dollars.

PACKING CHECKLIST

Tip: bring a universal plug adapter. Kenya uses UK-style (Type G) outlets and Rwanda uses European-style (Type C/J), both 230–240 volts. Most phone and laptop chargers handle this; check hair tools and other small appliances.

DOCUMENTS & MONEY

- ☐ Passport, plus a photocopy of the photo page (carry the copy; leave the passport at home base)
- ☐ Kenya ETA (electronic travel authorization), about \$30
- ☐ Rwanda visa, purchased on arrival
- ☐ Cash in \$5 bills for souvenirs and incidentals

CLOTHING

- ☐ Scrubs
- ☐ Comfortable closed-toe shoes
- ☐ Water shoes
- ☐ Light hooded jacket or windbreaker (waterproof)
- ☐ Sweater or sweatshirt
- ☐ Hat and sunglasses
- ☐ Modest swimwear

GEAR

- ☐ Battery-operated personal fan
- ☐ Large flashlight or headlamp
- ☐ Plenty of fresh batteries
- ☐ Universal plug adapter
- ☐ Water bottle
- ☐ Backpack or fanny pack for day programs
- ☐ Duct tape

HEALTH

- ☐ Anti-malaria medication (optional, recommended)
- ☐ Personal medications
- ☐ Personal first-aid kit
- ☐ Bug repellent spray or wristbands
- ☐ Chapstick with SPF
- ☐ Compression socks

ROOM & BATH

- ☐ Twin-size sheet set (Rwanda only)
- ☐ Two washcloths and two towels
- ☐ Toiletries and feminine products
- ☐ Toilet tissue
- ☐ Baby wipes (one restroom per floor)
- ☐ Earplugs (roosters start early!)

PERSONAL

- ☐ Bible and devotional material
- ☐ Compact notebook and pen
- ☐ Snacks
- ☐ Small board or card games for airports and downtime

HOW TO APPLY

1 Complete the online application

Fill out the Kenya-Rwanda mission trip application online. It includes your trip choice, personal and passport details, emergency contact, medical information, and the Oasis authorization and release.

2 Pay your \$250 non-refundable deposit with your application

Send funds through the [Whole Life Ministry Campaign on Zeffy](#), then purchase your flight.

3 Upload your documents

Upload a copy of your passport photo page, plus your current professional state license and certificates (if applicable), right on the application form.

4 Share your flight itinerary

If you are not on the group flight from Atlanta, email your itinerary so airport transportation can be arranged.
